Calling all modellers! We challenge you to mould and model clay in your own home to make a Fantastic Beast or an Amazing Animal!

From 3.30pm 8-13 June you can collect a ball of clay from Mrs Harvey, in Nursery, to take home and sculpt.

On Monday 3 July bring it back to school and have it fired in our very own school kiln.



This is one of Henry Moore's famous sculptures.

Henry Moore was an English artist. He decided he wanted to be a sculptor at the age of 11 and was best known for his semi-abstract sculptures which are located around the world at public works of art.

REMEMBER - joining pieces together isn't straight forward, first you need to use a fork to score (scratch) where the join will be and next use slip (mixture of water and clay) to push on pieces.



Solid models will blow up in the kiln! Try to hollow out the middle of your model or push holes high up into the model so it won't blow.



Name your model and take a photo of it before you bring it to school. Putting clay models in the kiln can be unpredictable and there is always a chance a model may not survive, please remember that making the model is the best part ... and you'll always have your photo.
