- ▶ We are so excited to be back at school with the children after a long break. We hope the children are looking forward to their time in Year 1.

Our School Day

- ▶ For Year 1, the school day starts at 8:40am (children need to now be in school by 845) and finishes at 3:15pm
 - Please ensure you are prompt for both drop off and pick up, to allow your child to have a smooth start and end to their day.

Year 1 Topics

- ▶ **English** During the Autumn term we will be looking at stories with repeating language, reciting poems and non-fiction writing.
- ▶ Mathematics This term we will be covering number formation, positional language, exploring numbers to 10 and 20 and 2D/3D shape.
- ▶ **Phonics** We will be continuing to follow the RWI programme. We will also begin learning to decode 'Alien Words' ready for the phonics screening towards the end of the academic year.

Year 1 Topics

- ▶ **Science** We will learning about The Body. We will be thinking about which parts of the body are used for different things and linking parts of the body to the five senses.
- Geography Our topic is 'Where do I Live?'. We will be learning to name the seven continents of the world, locating the UK on a world map and thinking about our local area.
- Computing This is taught weekly

Child Initiated Learning (CIL)

- ▶ In Year 1 the children will continue to have access CIL throughout the day.
- ▶ As the year progresses the amount of CIL gradually decreases.
- At school the children often refer to CIL as 'choosing time', as this is when they are able to choose their own learning.

Snack

- ▶ The school provides healthy snacks for children in Year 1.
- In Year 1 children take their snacks outside with them.
- Milk will continue to be available for those who would like it.

Lunch

- ▶ Children eat lunch in the hall or outside.
- ► Children bringing a packed lunch may bring a sensibly sized lunch box.

Spare Clothes

- ▶ Reading is an important part of Year 1, we want to develop the children's love of reading.
- ▶ Books will be changed on Thursdays but need to be in school every day as the paper copies of the RWI guided reading books will be changed every 3-5 days.

Homework

- We would like you to hear your child read at least three times a week, alongside any activities they may be set from RWI.
- ▶ Maths will be set every Thursday and due in for Tuesday. It will alternate between being set online through a website www.maths.co.uk and a written task which your child will complete in book. This will also be posted on Google classroom. You will be given a log on for maths.co.uk.
- ➤ You should have your child's username and password for Google Classroom, if you have any problems using the website let us know and we will be happy to help.
