Music	Pupils practise and perform a range of songs with increasing control and expression, singing with accurate pitch, and with an increasing awareness of historical and cultural context. Their solfege range extends beyond one octave, they participate in and conduct a feral choir, they execute and improvise phrases of up to 4 bars long and in 3 and 4 time, and they learn percussion patterns of increased complexity. Pupils move, vocalise, play, create and notate syncopated rhythms. Simple harmony - using the 1, 4 and 5 chords - is introduced, and pupils learn key musical forms such as ternary, verse and refrain, and the blues.
